Parade Officials and Volunteers:

- Parade Officials and Volunteers will be available to assist with questions or guidance you may need.
- Parade Officials and Volunteers will be available to check-in parade participants and direct them to their designated spots.
- All participants must follow the direction given by parade Volunteers and Officials.
- Parade rules and regulations will be reiterated during parade formation.

ALL Vehicle Operators:

- All vehicle drivers must be experienced operators and must possess the appropriate valid motor vehicle operator's licenses.
- All vehicles must be in sound working condition and properly registered and insured.
- Once a float or other vehicle is in position, the driver (and a float representative, if applicable) must be in attendance at all times in the event there are questions or the float and/or vehicle needs to be moved.

PLine-up and Staging:

- All parade entries will be assigned a placement for line-up before the parade begins.
- FLOATS: You will receive your assigned position at the mandatory Pre-Parade Meeting (date and location TBD)
- Non-float entries: You will receive your placement information when you check in with our parade volunteers. You are welcome to attend the Pre-Parade Meeting should you choose to do so.
- You and your participants will follow the order of placement (which may be subject to change) as directed by the Parade Officials and Volunteers.

Float Height and Length:

- Float entries must be structurally sound and must not exceed 13' 6" in height.
- Float length must be approved by the Parade Committee.
